



## **BALTECH Scholarship**

**Grants for bachelor, master and PhD students as well as teaching staff at BALTECH universities.**

### **1. Aim**

The aim of the BALTECH Scholarship is to enhance short term exchange and mobility of students between the BALTECH universities.

### **2. Announcement**

- 2.1. The BALTECH Scholarship is announced twice a year on [www.baltech.info](http://www.baltech.info) and by the International Relations Offices at the BALTECH universities.
- 2.2. Application deadlines: March 15, October 15.

### **3. Eligibility**

The BALTECH Scholarship is open for bachelor (minimum second year), master and PhD students as well as teaching staff up to 35 years of age at any of the BALTECH universities and within any study field offered by the universities.

### **4. Coverage**

- 4.1. The BALTECH Scholarship covers subsistence (100 euro/week), travel and participation costs for a maximum period of eight weeks. The scholarship is meant for studies, teaching, research projects, conferences/ symposiums and practical training at universities and/or companies.
- 4.2. The number of scholarships and the amounts are fixed annually at the BALTECH rectors' conference.

### **5. Application**

The following documents shall be handed in to the BALTECH Secretariat or to the International Relations Offices at any of the BALTECH universities:

- BALTECH scholarship application form (see: [www.baltech.info](http://www.baltech.info))
- Copies of academic transcripts
- Letter of recommendation from the supervisor
- Letter of motivation
- Curriculum Vitae (max one page)

### **6. Selection**

The BALTECH Secretariat is responsible for the evaluation process. The final decision is made by the BALTECH board. Consideration is given to academic success and a proper balance of students between BALTECH universities.

### **7. Reporting**

Each scholar shall submit a one page report to the BALTECH Secretariat and home university, not later than one month after completion of the assignment, indicating the main achievements and the benefits of the scholarship.
